

May 10, 2017: Village Board Special Meeting
Minutes of the Special Meeting Sodus Point Village Board

Mayor Tertinek called the special meeting to order at 4:02 PM

Present: Mayor Tertinek, Trustee McDowell, Trustee Kennedy, Trustee Eckberg, Deputy Mayor Kallusch
Public: None

Mayor Tertinek explained that the reason for the special meeting is to discuss the status of the Village sewer system. The Board has to decide what the trigger point is to shut the system down.

Trustee McDowell stated that his concern is that we don't know what will truly happen if we shut down.

The efforts have been focused on Maiden Lane, Clover St.

The pump trucks have been running 24 hours a day.

We loaned a trash pipe from Penfield Wastewater.

DEC gave us the ok to pump from Maiden Lane back in the bay. The Board agrees this will be a last resort.

The main lift station has 4 pumps.

1- out of commission

1- barely working

2 -working

Trustee McDowell is planning on approving the purchase of new pumps. The Board agreed it is necessary.

He also assured the Board that he felt that after the changes were made to the system in the next 2 days that the Village would not have to shut down Clover St. pump station yet.
