The Village of Sodus Point Zoning Board of Appeals was called to order by chairperson Tom Johns at 7:00 p.m. He stated that two items were advertised in the Wayne County Times and on the Village Website: an area variance request for John Wildhack, which was continued from the last meeting, and the Tidesides Marina application for several variances, which became postponed because the Village Planning Board did not complete its vote at its previous meeting.

Chairman Johns asked if anyone was on Zoom to represent the Wildhack variance request. No one dialed in, so this application was postponed at 7:14 p.m.

Chairman Johns advised that at its last meeting, the Planning Board had discussed and voted on the applicant's request to amend the Tidesides SEQR. It had not been able to complete the preliminary site review for this application. The Zoning Board will be reviewing variance requests on the marina application for length of docks, number of docks, boat house on dock and fuel platform on dock.

There being no further business, Ms. Bassage moved to adjourn the meeting, and Mr. Nesspor seconded the motion. Mr. Johns adjourned the meeting at 7:25 p.m.
